The **FEDERAZIONE ITALIANA SPORT DEL GHIACCIO** and the **ICE RINK PINE'** with the **COMITATO TRENINO** have the honour and pleasure to announce that the "**2° TRENTINO STARCLASS**" will be held on 5 – 7 October 2007 at Ice Rink Pinè in Baselga di Pinè in accordance with the 2006 Regulations of the **International Skating Union**, the '**StarClass Rules Regulations 2007/2008**' and the conditions included in this Announcement.

Entries

Entries can be made by the Club of the respective athlete or by the Member of the International Skating Union.

In the case of an unmanageable number of entries: reductions can be made by the organizers together with the Coordination Group. In this respect the total number of skaters in all categories per club may be limited and/or the number of Clubs may be limited. Principles like global representation, regional representation and first come, first served shall be applied.

Preliminary Entry

The Preliminary Entry specifying

- Date and Time of Departure and Arrival
- Number of accompanying Officials
- Provisional names

must be submitted by **5 September 2007** and is preferably to be made via www.shorttrackonline.info

Final Entry

The Final Entry specifying/confirming

- Number of athletes in each category
- Date and Time of Departure and Arrival
- Number of accompanying Officials
- Names of the Athletes and Best time skated on 500m distance for each one
- Names of the accompanying Officials

must be submitted at the latest by **30 September 2007** and is preferably made via www.ShortTrackOnline.Info

All Entries must be accompanied by sufficient documentation of the performances in Mass Start Competitions and all requirements of the ISU Regulations must be fulfilled (insurance, etc.).

ALL TEAMLEADERS are very urgently requested to inform the Organizers of any changes upon departure from their home-town, at the very latest.

Entry Fee

An Entrance Fee of 10 euros must be paid to the Organizers for each accredited person, e.g. for every athlete and for every coach/team leader. Per Club one coach/team leader does not have to pay the Entrance Fee.

Conditions of Contest

The Qualifying Schedule on each distance shall be based on an "All Finals System" in all categories. The All Final System is used in order to guarantee a minimum number of races to all participants. The organizers reserve the right to change the programme due to unforeseen circumstances.

Board and Lodging

The participating teams are responsible for their own meals and accommodation.

The hotel reservations must be addressed and submitted by 6 September 2007 to the Organizing Committee that will provide accommodation on full board at the price of EUR 45,00 and half board at the price of EUR 40,00 in double room per day per person. Supplement single room EUR 7,00 per day.

Track

The track is an artificial refrigerated indoor ice surface with the measures of 30x60 meters, protective padding will cover the boards. The standard track 111,12 meters to the lap with measured curves of 8,50 meters and there will be 7 markers used to establish the curve. The length of the straight is 28,85m. Besides the original track there will be 4 tracks set up to preserve good ice conditions. For all tracks one finish line will be used.

Award of Prizes

Prize for the first - second and third classed in the final results for each category - ladies and men. During award ceremonies, the skaters should be in club or National track suits.

Medical Assistance

Doctor and paramedical personnel will be present at the competition days. An ambulance will be on standby in case of need.

Medical Insurance

It is the sole responsibility of each Member, on behalf of its participating clubs, to ensure or provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes. Proof of such shall be requested by the Organizing Committee. See I.S.U. Rule 119.

Liability

In accordance with I.S.U. Rule 119, the Organizing Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this Competition.
