While Baselga is finalizing its preparations for this event, Champery's organizing engine is in motion for the next STAR CLASS COMPETITION - October 20th-21st which will see on the ice the 'Starclass', Junior A and Senior categories.

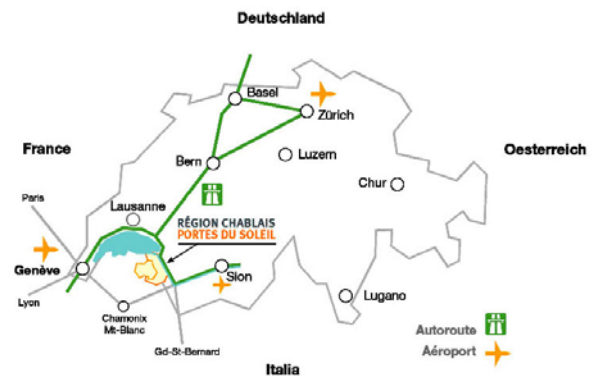


The Palladium stadium in Champery

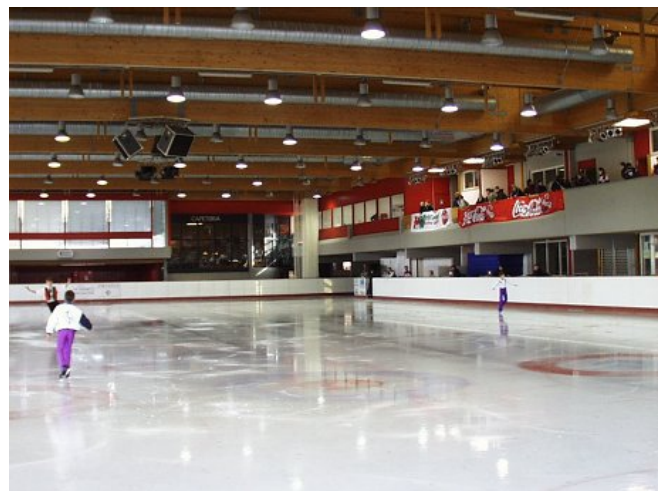
